Study Trip: Actors of EU-Policy in Stuttgart

Framework Information

The excursion to Stuttgart is dedicated to the actors who are active in fields of EU policy at Länder level in Stuttgart. We will visit the state parliament, the state ministry and the European departments of various other ministries. In addition, we will talk to a municipal umbrella organization and civil society EU actors such as the non-partisan Europa-Union and the Europa Zentrum Baden-Württemberg.

Logistics

The first day of the excursion, Tuesday, October 19th, 2021 takes place in presence in Stuttgart. The second day of the excursion, Wednesday, October 20th, 2021, takes place online on Zoom.

Students from Kehl must apply for a business trip permit at the “Service Zentrum Studium und Lehre” – early enough!

Students will travel to Stuttgart and back on their own responsibility and ensure that they are present in the “Europahaus” at 8:30 a.m. on 10/19/2021 in any case!

We are in the Europahaus the whole day, the speakers from the different institutions meet us there. We also join the guided tour of the Landtag visitors' service (online) from the Europahaus.

In the Europahaus itself - due to Corona measures - unfortunately no drinking and eating can be provided. However, you can bring something with you: It is therefore highly recommended that you take some provisions with you (the time from 8.30 - 14.00 is long).
